Roger Paul Hass, 75, of Fort Collins, Colorado, died December 30, 2021.

Roger was born October 13th, 1946 in Fremont, Nebraska to parents Elmer and Hope Hass. In Roger's high school years Roger was an accomplished wrestler and played the trumpet. In Fremont, Roger met, fell in love, and married Susan Freeman on July 21, 1967. In 1966 Roger joined the United States Marine Corps reserves and was honorably discharged after 6 years while obtaining the rank of Sergeant. In 1976 Roger, Sue and the kids moved to Kansas City, KS where he managed a foundry for 13 years after which he started a general contractor business called Select Builders. In 1989, the family relocated to Fort Collins, where Roger continued his craft as a general contractor. He owned and operated Select Builders in Fort Collins for nearly 30 years. After Roger sold his business in 2011 he remained active and continued to work on home improvement projects, he kept working for clients and continued his craft in wood working through September 2021.

Roger enjoyed everything outdoors, including hunting and fishing. Throughout Roger's entire life, he enjoyed boating and spending time on the water including fishing and water skiing. Although Roger was dedicated to his craft and clients, he always made time for his family, always putting them first. He never missed a game or school event, showing his support always to his family. Roger was dedicated to his Christian faith and served as trustee, usher and attended Bible study his entire life. Roger was very patriotic and proud of his service in the Marine Corps, which he passed on to his son Brian, who also served in the Marine Corp. In his work and his life, Roger was a Christian and family man.

Roger is survived by his beloved wife, Susan Hass; daughter Trisha Hass; son, Brian (Kristina) Hass; grandchildren, Caleb, Jakob, Brady, Emily, and Sara; and sister, Trudy (Bob) Jones.
