Alice Saldeen (Connour) of Loveland, CO passed away at MCR Saturday, August 1, 2015. She was 74 years old. Alice was born August 23, 1940 in Tuscola, IL. On February 13, 1960, she married Dwain Saldeen. In July 1977, Alice and Dwain, along with their children, Kevin and Kara, moved to Estes Park, CO, where they joined the staff at Covenant Heights Bible Camp. In Estes, she would brighten people's day and was everyone's favorite flower lady as she was the Floral Department Manager at Safeway for thirteen years. In 1995 they moved to Las Vegas, NV, where she worked as a master floral designer for the MGM Grand Hotel. She was an active member of Heart of the Rockies Christian Church in Fort Collins.
