Allen LeRoy Rein, 91, of Johnstown, Colorado died on September 3, 2017 in Loveland, Colorado.

He served in the United States Navy during World War II. He was a dispersing storekeeper in Quam and Saipan. He was very proud of his country and honored to serve it with pride.
