Anna (Ann) Haverluk, age 96 of Fort Collins, Colorado died September 7, 2025 at Morning Star Senior Living in Old Town Fort Collins. Recitation of the Holy Rosary will begin at 1:30 PM Wednesday, September 17, 2025 followed by Mass of Christian Burial at 2:00 PM at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Fort Collins. Interment will be with her husband, Sam in the North Dakota National Cemetery in Mandan, ND.

Anna Schmaltz was born March 3, 1929 in Hettinger, North Dakota to Margaret (Fix) and Christ Schmaltz. She attended Chandler Consolidated School and graduated from Hettinger High School. She also graduated from Capitol Commercial College at Bismarck.

Ann was employed by the Corps of Engineers, General Services Administration and retired from USDA as an administrative assistant.

On April 29, 1957, she married Sam Haverluk at St. Mary's Church in Bismarck. After their respective careers, they retired to Fort Collins in 1992 and Sam passed away January 4, 2002.

and was a Charter Member of the Newcomers Alumni Association.
