Beverly Ann Sinclair, 73, of Fort Collins, died on Saturday, October 2, 2021.

She was born on August 14, 1948 in Cheyenne, Wyoming to Ronald S. Sinclair and Lucille Ann (James) Sinclair and had one brother, Thomas E. Sinclair and two sisters, Mary Kay and Janice Kay, all of whom preceded her in death. The family lived at the Horticultural Field Station north of Cheyenne until 1963, when they moved to Fort Collins.

Beverly graduated from Fort Collins High School in 1966 and attended CSU. Jobs included, cashier at King Soopers, floral work at Paul Wood Florist, clerk at Gwen's Dress Shop, corporate office manager for Panhandler's Pizza, bookkeeper at Walgreens, office supervisor at Handy Dan Hardware, and her last job in the finance department for Larimer County government. She loved people and tried to help whenever she could and always tried to find the positive side of life.
