Bonnie Bonita Clifton, 89, from Craig, CO, passed away on April 2, 2022 in Loveland, CO. Bonnie was born to Leo and Ruth (Phipps) Dunn and raised in Craig, CO. After graduation from Moffat County High School Bonnie attended the University of Wyoming.
