She is survived by her daughters, son, and their spouses (Suzanne and

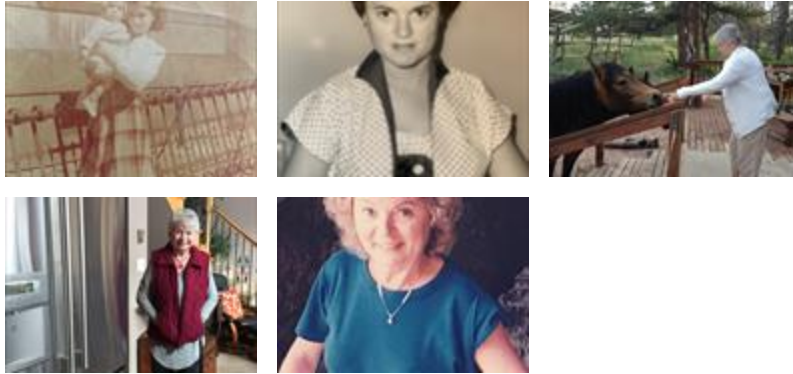
