Charles “Chuck” Irwin of Fort Collins, Colorado, passed away on April 6, 2022.

Chuck was born in 1936 in Vernon, New York to parents George and Vivian (Russell) Irwin. He graduated from VVS in 1954 and attended Mohawk Valley Community College. He married Rebecca Irwin in 1970. Chuck retired from Kodak in Windsor, Colorado in 1991.
