



## Cynthia Deanne Voas

November 24, 1951 - April 15, 2014

Cynthia (Logan) Voas passed peacefully into the arms of her Lord, April 15, 2014, surrounded by her loving family. Cancer took Cynthia despite a hard-fought two year battle. She was 62.

Cynthia Deanne Logan was the third child of Byrl and Luella (Tigner) Logan. She was born in Watertown, South Dakota on November 24th, 1951. She grew up on a farm and attended Logan Township School through the 8th grade. She graduated with honors from Clark (SD) High School in 1970.

Cynthia was united in marriage to Raleigh Voas on June 20th, 1971. They have three children.

Cindy, as she was called by her many friends, spent her life caring for and sharing her joy of life with others. Her sense of humor, love, and compassion for others was evident by the mutual respect and love she received from all who knew her.

Cindy began her life's work of care-giving in high school as a student nursing aide. Over the years she raised a family, enjoyed baking and sewing whenever possible, and completed a Registered Nursing Degree. Cindy especially loved working Obstetrics, but she also enjoyed Geriatrics. At the time her illness forced her to retire, she was the Assistant Director of Nursing at The Good Samaritan Village in Ft. Collins, Colorado.

Cindy loved nursing and expanded her outreach to others by active participation in her church. She taught Sunday School, volunteered and directed Vacation Bible Schools, and was an office-holder with the United Methodist Women (UMW). Many of the people she nursed with or met through UMW were an inspiration to her.

Cindy is survived by her parents, Byrl and Luella Logan of Clark, SD and three siblings; Douglas (Deb) of Bloomington, IL; Yvonne Logan of Watertown, SD; Sandra (Jay) Wano of Latrobe, PA, plus numerous aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces and nephews. She is also survived by her husband, Raleigh of Ft. Collins, their three children; Joshua (April) of Denver, CO, Angela (Rob) Combs of Aurora, CO, and Rebecca (Andy) Bowsher of Ft. Collins, CO. She has eleven grand children: Sawyer Voas, Blake Voas, Taven Voas, Cora Combs, Brenley Combs, Caden Combs, Elijah Bowsher, Isaiah Bowsher, Josiah Bowsher, Zebediah Bowsher, and Grace Bowsher. They brought the greatest of joy to her life. She often reminded them that "Grandma loves you Big Much."

Visitation will be held on Monday, April 21st from 7:00-8:00 pm at the First United Methodist Church at 1005 Stover Street - Fort Collins, CO. Interment will take place Tuesday, April 22nd at the Grandview Cemetery in Ft. Collins. Memorial Service will held at 2:00 pm Tuesday at First United Methodist Church. A Reception will follow in the Fellowship Hall at the church immediately after the service.

In lieu of flowers, the family asks that memorials be made to The Good Samaritan Village of Ft. Collins, the UMW of the 1st United Methodist Church of Ft. Collins or the Memorial Hospital of Carbon County in Rawlins, Wyoming.
