



## Deborah Kathleen Turner

March 1, 1963 - September 23, 2014

Deborah Wolfe Turner, 51, from Fort Collins, passed away September 23, 2014, from complications from breast cancer. Deborah was born on March 1, 1963 in South Lake Tahoe, California, to Ted and Carolyn Wolfe. She is survived by her husband, Mark E. Turner, whom she married on May 15, 1993, in South Burlington, Vermont, and by her children Evan and Carolyn, and by her sisters Karen (Jack) McGinley, Reno, Nevada, and Alane (Brandon) Pearce, Odenton, Maryland, and her parents of Zephyr Cove, Nevada.

Deborah graduated from Whittell High School in 1981, and was valedictorian of her class. She graduated in 1985 from the University of Nevada, Reno, with a major in Finance.

Deborah began her career with Job Corps, in Reno, and after several moves rose to Recruitment, Screening, and Placement Manager with Job Corps in Middlebury, Vermont. After her wedding, she raised Evan and Carolyn. In 1997, the family moved to Fort Collins with her husband's career. In 2003, the Turners opened a Maid Brigade home cleaning franchise and Deborah served as Office Manager. In 2007, she joined Adamson Family Care and soon became the Office Manager until failing health forced her to resign.

She was a member of Heart of the Rockies Christian Church (Disciples of

Christ) where she served as elder and chair of the elders. She was an advisor for a family receiving a home through Habitat for Humanity. She was a PEO sister in Chapter IK. She also served as a CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate) in Larimer County. Deborah enjoyed scrap-booking and raising her children. In 2013, she was chosen to be a model for Hope Lives, a Fort Collins nonprofit, supporting women with breast cancer.

She was loved for her wonderful sense of humor and her loving and caring spirit. She will be greatly missed by all who knew her.
