Dorothy Taylor passed away peacefully at the Good Samaritan Center of Fort Collins on July 7, 2016. Dorothy was born on December 21, 1928, in Northfield, Minnesota, to Beth Street Henry and Ralph Ledyard Henry.

Following a long line of Henry and Street family members who attended Carleton College in Northfield, Dorothy graduated from Carleton College in 1950 with a B.A. in French.
