Dylan A. Salas, 19, of Fort Collins, died Sunday night.

A 2016 graduate of Rocky Mountain High School, Dylan was born and raised in Fort Collins. In school and in life, he was an athlete, a leader, and a friend. Dylan was a two-year letterman in Golf at RMHS. He also enjoyed playing soccer for both RMHS and Arsenal as well as basketball with Rocky Mountain Fever.

Besides his athletic achievements, Dylan was also part of leadership programs, DECA (Distribute Education Clubs of America) and FBLA (Future Business Leaders of America) in high school. He was in Boy Scout Troop 90 and loved going camping with his fellow scouts and dad. He loved people and being around others. “ I coached Dylan in Soccer for many years and knew the family well. Dylan was a competitor and always wanted to be the best he could be. Around age 11, he was on my Arsenal team and our training landed just a day or two before Halloween. As we wrapped up practice, I pulled the boys together and talked with them about eating well before the game and avoiding candy on gameday. As they began to disperse, I joked that I like Snickers bars and that could go a long way in earning playing time. I vividly remember Dylan stopping in his tracks, turning around and looking at me and then off he went to head for home.

The following practice (after halloween) many of the boys showed up with snickers bars.. Some were just one or two, a couple had small Ziplock bags.. Dylan brought a gallon ziplock bag filled to the top. Apparently, he took what I said very seriously. We got such a good laugh out of it. Well, over the coming week or two, he kept bringing more and even though I told him to stop, each day he would walk by my coaches bag and toss a couple on top. Eventually I asked where he was getting all of these Snickers bars? He looked over his shoulder, then looked back at me and quietly said "My sisters Halloween candy." and then quickly said "But you can't tell!!!"

I enjoyed my time with Dylan and am just heartbroken of this senseless loss.
