Ed passed away peacefully on June 1, 2024, at Pathways in Fort Collins, Colorado. He was born on March 11, 1941 in Philadelphia, PA to Edward Duster and Anna (Miller) Hurtubis.

He first met Mary Leona (Mimi) Carmosky while both attended the Pennsylvania State University in Pottsville, PA and State College, PA. After he graduated in 1964, they moved to Rochester, New York for his job at the Eastman Kodak Company, and had two daughters.
