Floyd J Holsinger passed away at Shamrock Manor in Fort Collins, Colorado on September 14, 2014 at the age of 96.

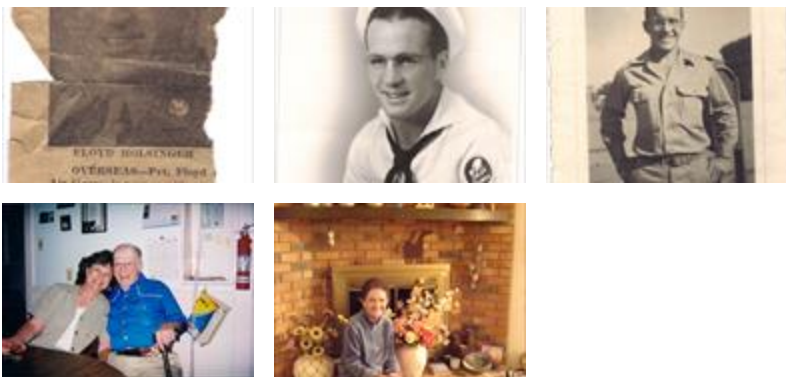
