Grace Scheer, age 63 of Fort Collins, Colorado died March 4, 2010 at her home after a two year battle with cancer. Grace Ruth Blakemore was born March 1, 1947 in Nyack, New York to David and Edith Blakemore. She lived in Philadelphia until the age of 14 and moved to Cheyenne, Wyoming in 1961. Grace married Dennis Scheer on September 1, 1967 in Cheyenne and subsequently, received her Bachelors and Masters degrees in School Counseling from the University of Wyoming in Laramie. They moved around the country over the years and settled in Fort Collins in 1999. Her most recent school counseling work was done at Ault's Highland High School.
