September 18, 1933 - September 10, 2016

Beloved father, husband, brother, and friend, James (Jim) Taylor, 82, of Fort Collins, CO passed away Saturday, September 10th at Good Samaritan Village.

He was born in Chicago, Illinois on September 18, 1933 to parents Arthur William Taylor and Georgia Ellen Brain Taylor.
