Jean Terese Oliver, age 81 of Fort Collins, Colorado, died July 20, 2009. A memorial mass will be held 10:30 am Saturday, September 5, 2009 at Blessed John 23rd University Parish. In Hawaii she was 2nd Trustee of Honolulu Emblem Club at the Elks Club in Honolulu. Her husband of 52 years died in 1997. She was predeceased by her son, Kenneth C. Oliver 1st Lt. in the US Army in 1968. She was also predeceased by brothers Robert, James, Arthur, Freddy, Alan (Hersey) and one sister, Carolyn Morgan. Jean is survived by her daughter, Michele (of Kelseyville, CA) and son, Gregory (of Loveland, CO) as well as their
