November 29, 1943 - April 27, 2009

Jerry “Papa” McTeer, age 65 of Loveland, Colorado, formerly of Kansas City, Missouri died April 27, 2009 at his home. A memorial service will be held at 7:00 p.m. Saturday at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, 3800 Mountain Lion Dr. in Loveland. Cremation is planned. Jerry Dean McTeer was born in Wheaton, Missouri to Glen and Pauline McTeer. He married Teri on July 31, 1980 in Shawnee Mission, Kansas. He worked in Data Processing at the Commerce Bank in Kansas City for many years. A job transfer brought him to Colorado in 1992 where he worked for IBM in Boulder, CO.
