He received his Bachelor's in Finance from Colorado State University in 2000, and worked for his father as an Insurance Agent for 25 years. On July 7, 2011, he married his best friend, Laura Elizabeth Lawser, and they were together for 10 years. They had a son together, Chance, who is now 6 years old.

His humor despite his many health struggles was one of his most amazing qualities and he touched many around him with his jokes and quick wit. He was a fighting spirit with incredible determination and a bright soul.

and Patricia Lawser, and several cousins, aunts, and 1 uncle. John was a family man and he was proud of his marriage and son. Funeral services have been put on hold at this time due to the pandemic.
