John Denneen Weigand, 84, of Fort Collins, Colorado, passed away April 23, 2014. John was born October 26, 1929 in Wichita, Kansas to John A. and Irene (Denneen) Weigand. He graduated from Wichita High School East and Wichita State University (B.A. and M.S. in Chemistry). After graduation, John served in the United States Army from July 1954 until June 1956. John worked most of his life in the chemical industry and retired from Colorado State University in 1994 after working at the Lory Student Center for 10 years.

On May 23, 1964 John was married to Lucille Kiecker in Minneapolis, Minnesota.
