June Evelyn Mihalek, age 92 of Fort Collins, Colorado, formerly of Pontiac, Michigan, died October 25, 2009 at a local rehabilitation facility. Cremation is planned and a committal service will be held at noon Wednesday at Fort Logan National Cemetery in Denver.
