Kathleen Mary Burrell, age 64 of Fort Collins, Colorado, died August 21st as a result of a fire at her home. Recitation of the Holy Rosary will begin at 3:30 pm Friday at St. Joseph Catholic Church, Fort Collins with the celebration of a Mass of Resurrection by Fr. Steven Voss at 4. A reception will be held immediately following services at the Knights of Columbus Hall. Interment will be in Most Holy Redeemer Cemetery in Schenectady, NY. After graduating from Albany Junior College as a Registered Nurse, Kathie worked as an occupational health nurse/disability case manager at Hewlett Packard/Agilent Technologies/Avago Technologies in Fort Collins from 1981 to up to just a few years ago.
