Kevin W Genschoreck, age 52, of Fort Collins, Colorado died August 3, 2012 at home. Cremation has taken place and a memorial service and celebration of Kevin's life will be held on Friday, August 10 at 10:00 AM at Wellington Community Church, Wellington. Kevin was born September 12, 1959 to Billie and Elizabeth (Tholl) Genschoreck. He spent his childhood days in Lincoln, NE; lived briefly in Hanover and Marietta, KS; and came to Fort Collins when he was 17. For the past 10 years, Kevin owned and operated a vending machine business that served many happy customers. Kevin was preceded in death by his parents, most recently his mother, whom he missed quite dearly, and who passed away just this past November.
