She is survived by her sister, Jean (Chuck) West; brother, Jay (Sue) Dickson, and many close extended family members.

In 1995 after the death of her Father, Lynda moved back to Colorado to live with and help care for her mother.

Some of her favorite adventures were trips to England, Alaska and cruises around the world. Her last adventure was to Atlanta for her cousins 60th birthday. It would be the last time the Dickson family would be together with

her.

Whether it was taking her nieces to movies, playing cards with aunts and cousins or just celebrating holidays, she was always there for them. Lynda had many “families” that she treasured, she loved and cared deeply for her friends, co-workers and church members. They made her life worthwhile and fulfilling. She had a great sense of humor and a quick wit, and will be greatly missed by many.
