Marianne Colton Deshon Bullock, 93 of Fort Collins died November 2, 2015 of lung cancer. She was born April 25, 1922 in Nampa, Idaho to Rachel Griffith Colton and Cyril Hague Colton. She was raised in Denver, CO, graduating from East High School. She attended University of Denver where she started a lifelong affiliation with Pi Beta Phi.
