



Marilyn Emily Krogh

January 21, 1930 - August 12, 2015

Marilyn Krogh of Fort Collins died August 12, 2015 in Fort Collins, Colorado. The youngest of ten children, Marilyn Emily Lewis was born on the family farm on January 21, 1930, to Arthur and Kate Lewis of Hawley, Minnesota. She graduated from Hawley High School in 1948 and in 1952. Later, she married her high school sweetheart, Milton Krogh, who enlisted in the Air Force. This started her life as a military wife moving to Oklahoma, California, Texas, Japan, Philippines, New Jersey and Virginia. She had a quiet strength that was needed when Milt was gone on numerous TDY's. Following Milt's retirement from the Air Force in 1971, their love of wide open spaces brought them to Fort Collins where Milt got a job at Colorado State University and Marilyn sewed drapes for a local business and later, purchased and managed the Singer Sewing Store on North College where she also repaired sewing machines. When Milt retired a second time, they continued their travels, volunteer activities and did whatever they felt like doing including spending summers near Pelican Rapids, Minnesota.

Family always came first for Marilyn but she was passionate about sewing, which she loved to share with family and friends. She was always quick and willing to lend a hand to anyone. She was a long time member and leader of the Panty Parlor, a non-profit group that made underwear for children in need until her health required more care in 2014. She sewed more than 50 blankets for Project Linus and delivered Meals on Wheels and for all of her volunteer

efforts; she was recognized for being an outstanding volunteer in Fort Collins in 1987. She was a tireless volunteer for Christ United Methodist Church and sang in the choir for more than 30 years.

Marilyn is survived by her children: Daughters, Diane Krogh; Denise (Steve) Haynes; Deborah (Daniel) Michna and son, Steven (Michelle) Krogh. Eight grandchildren and ten great grandchildren and many more additions to the family through marriages. In addition she is survived by her sister, Susan Sorenson of Woodbury, MN; brother-in-law, Kenneth Jensen; sister-in-law, Donna Krogh Stratton; brother- and sister-in-law, Lyle and Delores Krogh; and many nieces and nephews.

She is preceded in death by her husband of 57 years, Milton; parents, Arthur and Kate Lewis; brothers, Milford, Verne and Charles; and sisters, Beatrice, Elda, Evelyn, Leona and Luella.
