Mark Alan DeLauter, age 57, of Fort Collins died April 13, 2010. A Memorial Service will be held on Saturday, April 24th at 3:00 PM at Christ United Methodist Church, 301 East Drake Road, Fort Collins. Mark was born on March 13, 1953 in Cloquet, Minnesota to David and Gloria DeLauter.
