



## Maxine Mae Peterson

December 8, 1932 - April 20, 2017

Maxine (Hansohn) Peterson, age 84, of Fort Collins, Colorado died Thursday, April 20, 2017 at Golden Peaks Care Center in Fort Collins. Maxine Mae Hansohn was born on December 8, 1932, in Sac City, Iowa, to Wilhelm (“Bill”) and Mabel (Anderson) Hansohn. The family moved to Holstein, Iowa where Maxine attended school and graduated from Holstein High School in 1950.

On January 30, 1951, Maxine was united in marriage to W. Eugene (“Pete”) Peterson. She enjoyed spending time with her family and going for drives in her beloved Rocky Mountains. Family was a very important part of Maxine’s life and took a special interest in their lives. She travelled with family to Washington and Oregon, New England, Niagara Falls, Florida, New Jersey and the Jersey shore, Philadelphia and New York City.
