Mike TeMaat, 85, died unexpectedly of a heart attack on Monday, August 22 in Fort Collins. He was born in Denver, CO on September 23, 1936, son of Raymond and Madelyn TeMaat. Mike graduated from South High School in Denver in 1954. Following graduation, he served with the U.S. Navy from 1954 to 1957 and was stationed at the Naval Security in Washington, D.C.
