Owen was born May 20, 2009 at Poudre Valley Hospital in Ft. Collins to Amylynn Sciera Johnston and Jason Michael Johnston and is the little brother of Elijah Sciera Johnston. He is also survived by his maternal grandparents Jennifer and Paul Sciera of Highlands Ranch; his paternal grandparents, Jani and Bruce Johnston of Centennial; aunt and uncles, Michelle and Vinay Shah of Colorado Springs and C. Ryan "Bear" Johnston of Denver; and cousins, Torin and Tyrus Shah. Owen was a happy little boy, a fighter and a real trooper. He suffered from Biliary Atresia requiring a liver transplant that was complicated by a debilitating infection that was more than his little body could handle.
