Pat B. Gorsuch, 76, of Corpus Christi, TX and Ft. Collins, CO, died Tuesday September 2, 2008 after a truly courageous battle with lymphoma, in her home in Ft. Collins, where she had been cared for by her daughter Megan. Born June 12, 1932 in Baltimore, MD to Erwin 'Bud' M. and Ruth (Glickman) Budner, she lived with her family in Delaware.
