Her skills and passion saw her helm many books to publication, including the delightful 'Building and Flying Indoor Model Airplanes' by Ron Williams, and Marcella Hazan's 'The Classic Italian Cookbook.' She was also an author in her own right, with a wide range of subject and formats - including 'Perfect Needlepoint Projects from Start to Finish' with Kathy Archer, 'A Swarm of WASPs' and fiction thriller 'Best Friend.' Her later career included historic preservation, interior design, finish carpentry, and upon retirement a deeper love of gardening, cooking, knitting, knitwear design, and spending time with her beloved dogs.

She is survived by her daughter Mary and numerous dear friends from across the decades.
