Rita Flemming, age 82 of Fort Collins, Colorado, passed away peacefully on Saturday, April 27, 2013 at her home, due to a weakened heart and multiple other symptoms.

Rita Lucille Morrow was born in 1930 in Hamlin, Maine to Joseph and Marie (Doucette) Morrow. She had many wonderful childhood tales of growing up on the Morrow family farm in Van Buren, Maine with her 12 beloved brothers and sisters.

Rita married Ronald Edward Flemming, originally of Woodstock, New Brunswick, Canada, in 1951, and they raised their family of 5 children together; primarily residing in New Jersey. Rita was an exceptional mother; and her children enjoyed a great sense of extended family through many cousins, aunts and uncles; along with fond memories of camping, outings, and creative projects. Ronald and Rita retired and moved to Colorado in 1988, where they enjoyed being near family. For years they enjoyed motor home traveling and camping, and winter escapes to Texas and Arizona.

She loved gardening and seeing plants grow. In later years she read diversely, critiqued movies, enjoyed bridge, pursued landscape painting, and orchestrated many home projects with her grandchildren.

She is survived by her 5 children, Gregory, Ronald, Hugh-John, Brenda and Helen; 11 grandchildren; 2 great-grandchildren; and several brothers and sisters.

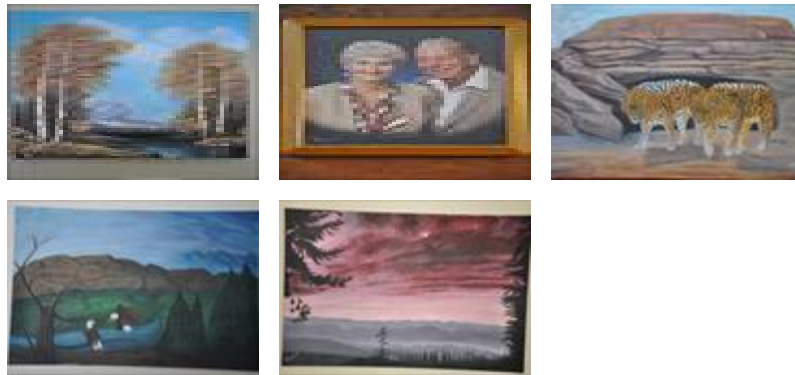

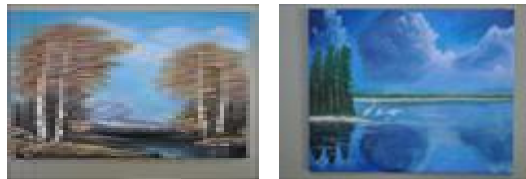
