Robert H. Meyer, 79, of Fort Collins, died August 24, 2018 at his home.

One of ten children, Bob was born in Valparaiso, Indiana to Andy and Emma Meyer. He graduated from Valparaiso High School and afterward joined the Navy. In 1962, also in Valparaiso, he married Ruth Ann, and they began a family together.

Bob continued his education, completing a program and apprenticeship to become an electrician. He was a member of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) – Local 697, earning his 50-year pin with them.
