



## Robert Casselman

January 17, 1949 - April 11, 2012

Robert "Bob" Casselman, 63, of Red Feather Lakes, CO passed away at home on April 11th, 2012. He was the oldest son born in Lincoln, NE to Ruth and Dean Casselman on January 17, 1949. Bob graduated with a degree in theater, music and teaching at the University of Northern Colorado and enjoyed time in a traveling theater company and teaching school children. Bob always enjoyed playing music and performing with his brother "Chuck" as well as many other great musicians. He often spoke of how fulfilling his life felt entertaining others and instilled a great love of music in his children. He spent many years working at the Fox Acres Country Club finalizing his career as the assistant super attendant of greens crew and took pride in his work there. He was survived by his mother Ruth Casselman, his sister Jo Rae Burns, and brother Mike Casselman all of southern Ca.
