January 4, 1954 - January 19, 2008

Robert E. Conway, of 3916 Terry Lake Rd., Fort Collins, died Saturday, January 19th of complications due to cancer at the age of 54. Bob lived in Fort Collins for thirty years. During that time, he was a devoted employee of the Tunnel Water Supply and Storage Company.
