Robert E. (Gene) Risley, 72, of Fort Collins, died November 13, 2019. Gene was born in Decatur, IL the son of Paul E. Risley and F. Eloise Risley, both deceased. 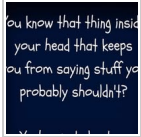
