Rochelle Ann Bratton of Fort Collins, Colorado passed away Saturday, February 25, 2012. Rochelle was born in Fargo, North Dakota on July 28, 1957. She grew up in Dickinson, North Dakota where she was the oldest of five children. Rochelle was an honored varsity basketball player during her high school years. She was a graduate of Dickinson State University where she received her Bachelors Degree in Elementary Education in 1979. She taught kindergarten in Dickinson, North Dakota until moving to Colorado.
