Ronald (Ron) Earl Dold, age 84, passed away on September 25, 2022 at Littleton Adventist Hospital in Littleton, CO.

Ron was born in Ashton, Nebraska to Rufus and Cecilia Dold on May 7, 1938. Ron was on the Ashton High School basketball team and also the 8-man football team. His parents moved to Grand Island, NE in his later high school years and Ron graduated from Grand Island High School in 1956. Ron was in the Army Reserves and received his training at Fort Leonard Wood in Missouri right after high school.

Ron was employed with the United States Bureau of Reclamation as an Inspector where he worked on several projects in many different states until he retired in 1994. His most prominent project was the initiation and completion of McPhee Reservoir in Cortez, CO. 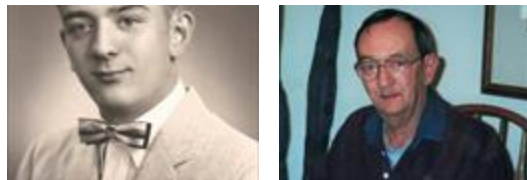
