Shirley Kilmer Ward, age 88, Estes Park, CO, passed away on Tuesday, December 11, 2012 at Prospect Park Living Center in Estes Park. She was born in Kirwin, KS on January 05, 1924, to the late William and Olive (Richards) Kilmer. She was united in marriage on Feb 13, 1942 to Arlin B. Ward and was blessed with four children. The Wards spent most of their lives in Manhattan, Kansas, and almost every summer they created cherished memories at the family cabin in Estes Park.
