Susan Lynn Ofe Webster, 57, of Windsor, Colorado passed peacefully in her home Thursday, Jan. 17, 2013 following a courageous battle with brain cancer/GBM.

Born March 1, 1955 in Fort Benning, Georgia to Carl and Jayne (Gorton) Ofe, she grew up in Nebraska where she graduated from Plattsmouth High School in 1973. Susan attended Clarkson School of Nursing in Omaha, NE and began her distinguished professional nursing service in the CCU for Clarkson Hospital. Susan relocated to Fort Collins, CO in 1977 where she was employed at McKee Medical Center in Loveland, CO and Kaiser Permanente in Denver, CO. She then served as a flight nurse for Airlife in Greeley, CO. Following a wedding proposal at Airlife's landing pad located in Rocky Mountain National Park in the fall of 1991, Susan and Ken Webster were united in marriage on August 14, 1992 in Glenwood Springs, CO.

Susan's most recent nursing career path began in 1988 with Poudre Valley Health Systems/University of Colorado Health where she currently served as the Trauma Performance Improvement Coordinator. Susan was a champion in establishing the Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) program with PVHS and the Fort Collins Police. She was the recipient of various awards and honors including employee of the year, being nominated as a Nightingale Award finalist, and being recognized for her passionate SANE endeavors through the Fort Collins Police Services.

A loving wife, mother, daughter, sister, grandmother, aunt, niece, and devoted

nurse, Susan had a great affection for Red Feather Lakes, CO. An avid travel connoisseur, Susan was always planning that next big adventure. Susan was extremely fond of beach travels with family and with her 'Menos'. Susan was fond of Big Red Nebraska Football, Colorado Eagles Hockey, Denver Broncos Football, and golfing with family and friends.
