She is survived by her mother Jane Slezak, siblings Lisa, Greg, and Steve Mahler, stepmother Sherry Mahler, aunts Marlis Mahler and Carol Slezak, uncles Ken (Marilyn) Slezak and Tom Slezak, nieces Annika Mahler, Ella Mahler, and Teilor Mahler, cousins Frances, Laura, Anne, and Marissa Slezak, roommate extraordinaire Adalyn Prewett, and her second family, the Prewetts. 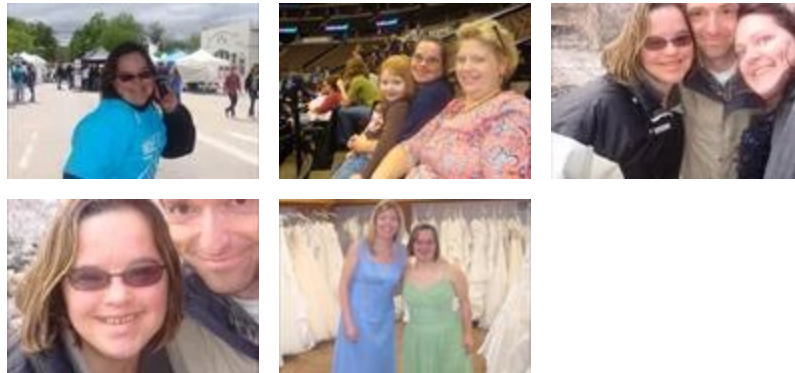

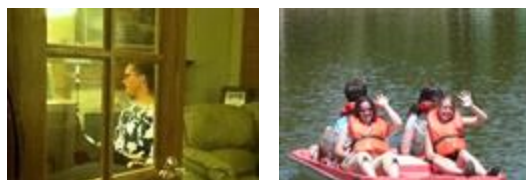

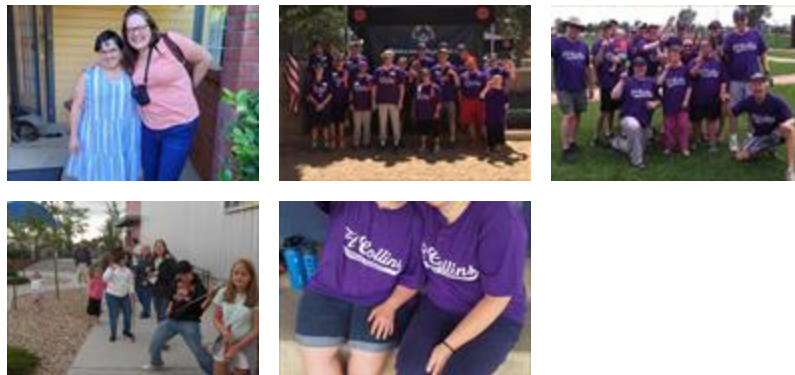
