Tom Miller, 64, of Ft. Collins, Colorado passed away on Wednesday December 20, 2017 at Medical Center of the Rockies in Loveland, Colorado. He was born in Iowa during a University of Iowa football game. At his birth the nurses pronounced his mother had scored a “touchdown”. He carried this nickname the rest of his life.

Tom’s family lived in Kinross, Iowa while he was growing up then moved to Espanola, New Mexico in 1971.
