Viola Belle Zimmerman, 88, of Ft. Collins died June 23 at home following a two year battle with cancer. Belle was born February 12, 1922, graduated Valedictorian from Daley High School in 1940. She attended Colorado State College of Education (now UNC) on a scholarship. Belle married Orville K. Zimmerman while he was in the service on October 11, 1942. They ranched and farmed near Haxtun, Colorado. They moved to Ft. Collins in 1965 where they managed apartment complexes until their retirement in 1984.
