“ Here's the way it works:When a person dies, any atsess he leaves behind (cash in a bank, a house, furnishings, etc.) goes into his estate . The deceased should have written a will which, amongst other things, states who will be the estate executor . This is often a close relative. The estate executor, beginning shortly after the death, begins to inventory the atsess and the liabilities (debts that are owed) that were left behind by the deceased. The estate executor pays off any debts (such as loans, final hospital bills, etc.) using the atsess from the deceased. Once the debts are paid off, anything left over is distributed to the heirs, as detailed in the will.If the person dies without much in the way of atsess (which unfortunately is pretty common), the obligations may never be paid off. In short, the people who are owed money (credit card companies, etc.) just have to write it off, knowing that they will never get paid.In short, your husband is largely wrong. You can't just get the goodies (the atsess) without paying off the liabilities (the amounts that are owed). If you try to do it that way, you'll be hit by lawsuits, and possible charges of fraud. He's right to the extent that you don't have to reach into your own savings (not including the atsess of the deceased) to pay off the debts.
