



Wanda Hoffmann

March 21, 1931 - September 25, 2013

Wanda Marie Hoffmann passed away on Wednesday September 25th, 2013 at the age of 82 at her home in Ft. Collins, Colorado.

Wanda was born to Richard and Garnet (McNally) St. Clair on March 21st, 1931 in Kahoka, Missouri. Wanda grew up in Kahoka, Missouri attending Clark County Schools, playing on the women's basketball team and one year her team won the Clark County Women's basketball Championship. Wanda was involved in 4-H growing up which led to her lifelong love of horses, in particular her horse Rex. Wanda attended college at Kirksville State Teachers College in Kirksville, Missouri where she first became a member of the Delta Zeta Sorority. Her affiliation with the Delta Zeta Sorority was a great source of pleasure to Wanda her entire life.

While attending college Wanda met her first husband Robert Pister and they were married in March of 1951. Robert passed away in 1959, and Wanda married Klaus Dieter Hoffmann in March of 1961 in Münster, Germany. Wanda and Klaus were together for over 4 decades raising their son Rob and daughter Lisa. Wanda and Klaus met in Kirksville, Missouri, moved to Iowa City, Iowa, and then in 1968 to Fort Collins, Colorado. They quickly fell in love with Fort Collins and Colorado and never left.

Wanda was preceded in death by husbands, Bob and Klaus, and loving

companion in her later years, Donell (Brad) Heck, as well as her daughter in-law, Mary Hoffmann and one of her three granddaughters, Carly Hoffmann. Wanda is survived by her son, Rob, daughter, Lisa (Paul) Nelson, and granddaughters, Kelsey and Stephanie Hoffmann.

Wanda loved animals, and always felt very strongly about organizations with animal welfare as their primary mission.
